## Why It's Important to Pray With Others

### Quick Study Guide

#### I. United prayer.

- United prayer happens in groups, church settings, prayer meetings, fellowship meetings and when the whole church prays together.
- The whole group prays in agreement.
- The pastor should determine ahead of time what scriptures are going to be prayed before the group gets together.
- Don't pray the problem—pray the will of God.
- The group should pray in faith believing the Word of God.

#### II. Elements of united prayer.

- Praise God.
- Announce what promise of God the group is using to believe for the answer to the prayer.
- Petition God for the answer to a specific prayer.
- Intercede for the sick and those who don't know Jesus as Savior and Lord.

#### III. Results of united prayer.

- The church comes together in praise, petition and intercession on God's Word expecting change in people and situations.
- God shows that Jesus is alive by saving and healing many.
- God answers these prayers of faith.

## Scriptures for Contemplation

### Acts 4:23-24

*“As soon as they were freed, Peter and John returned to the other believers and told them what the leading priests and elders had said. When they heard the report, all the believers lifted their voices together in prayer to God” (NLT).*

### Acts 4:29-30

*“And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching your word. Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus” (NLT).*

### Acts 5:12-16

*“The apostles were performing many miraculous signs and wonders among the people. And all the believers were meeting regularly at the Temple in the area known as Solomon’s Colonnade. But no one else dared to join them, even though all the people had high regard for them. Yet more and more people believed and were brought to the Lord—crowds of both men and women. As a result of the apostles’ work, sick people were brought out into the streets on beds and mats so that Peter’s shadow might fall across some of them as he went by. Crowds came from the villages around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those possessed by evil spirits, and they were all healed” (NLT).*
